The Senior Freeze Program in New Jersey

This program <u>reimburses eligible senior citizens</u> and disabled persons for property tax increases on their principal residence.

The maximum combined income limit went up significantly, so you may qualify now if you were ineligible in the past. This topic will be discussed at our October 9th meeting, but we suggest you familiarize yourself with it before the meeting.

There are eligibility requirements for each year from the base year through the application year. Some of the qualifiers are:

- you (or your spouse/civil union partner) were: 65 or older on December 31, 2022, and
- you owned and lived in your home since December 31, 2019, or earlier (and you still owned) and lived in that home on December 31, 2023.

The 2022 property taxes due on your home must have been paid by June 1, 2023, and the 2023 property taxes must be paid by June 1, 2024.

Your total annual income was: in 2022 - \$150,000 or less; and in 2023 - \$163,050 or less.

The program provides relief to residents struggling with property tax payments on their personal homes. The deadline for applying is October 31.
